

2015 Salmon in the Schools

The Michigan DNR has 253 classrooms that participate in the Salmon in the Classroom program. The South Haven chapter of the Steelheaders has three schools they partner with in the program.



Our longest participating teacher is **Ms Jane Larson** 6th grade teacher at **Paw Paw Middle school**. Jane, in her 3rd year, has 165 students that will benefit from the program.



Mr. Bryan Edwards is a 6th grade teacher at **South Haven Baseline Middle school**. This is Bryan's first year in the program taking over from Kevin Powell who was transferred to Lake Michigan College. Bryan has 2 classes of 165 each that will participate in the program.



Ms Sara Gilson is a 6th grade teacher from **Coloma Middle school**. Sara is in her first year of the program. Sara has 160 kids in the program. Sara is taking over from Kevin Oiles.

All of the teachers are excited about the program and the impact it will have on the students.

Wolf Lake fish hatchery held a one day workshop on 11-5-14 for teachers from all over the state to talk about the program, pass out materials, and give the teachers their eggs. Each teacher received about 200 "eyed" Chinook eggs to place in their classrooms.
